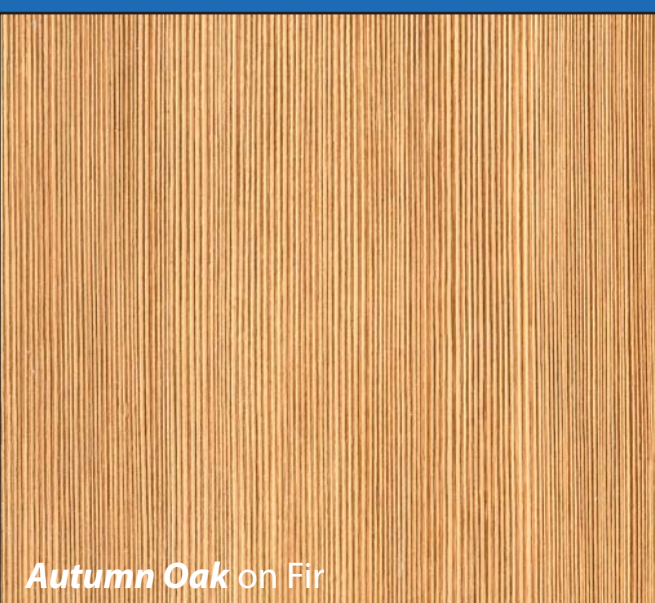

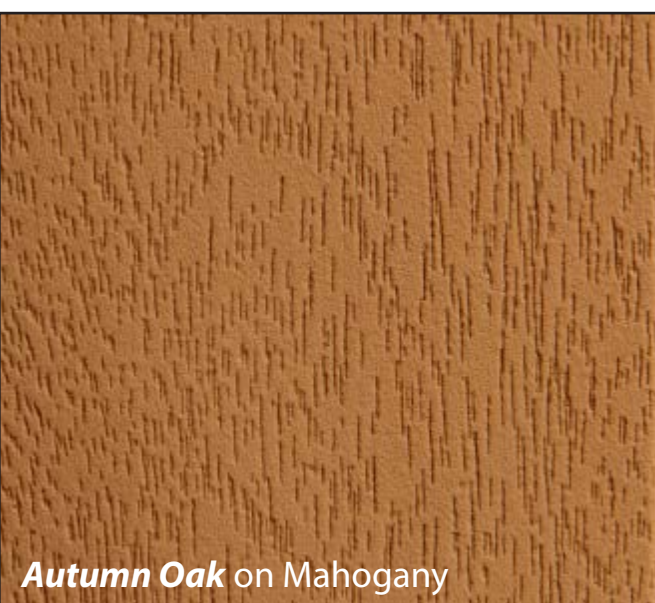
Topcoat Maintenance

- » Masonite recommends cleaning their doors and sidelites a few times a year using a mild detergent with warm water. They also recommend repairing and re-applying the topcoat every 1 to 2 years using a high-quality, UV stabilized, clear exterior polyurethane coating.
- » Refer to the installation and finishing instructions on the Masonite website. 
- » Follow the topcoat manufacturer's instructions carefully.

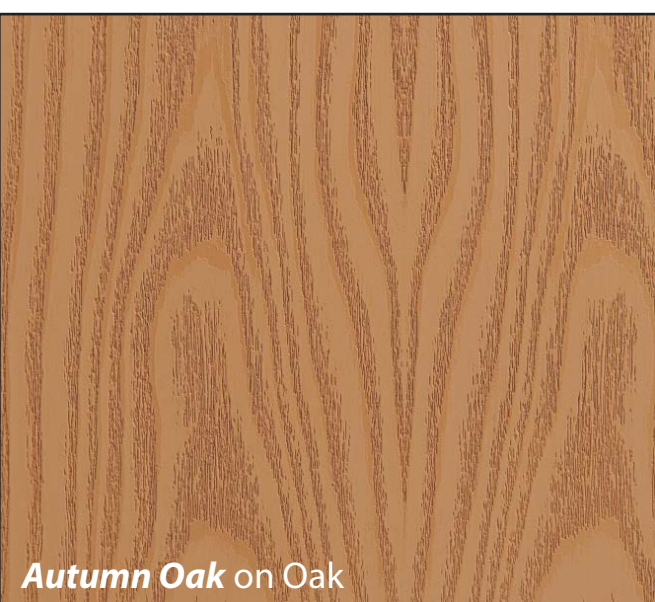
